WASHINGTON, March 2.—Movements of vessels follow, all dates are March 1, unless specified:

At San Pedro: Bobolink, California.

At San Diego: Gilmer, Wright.

Bridge, at San Francisco.

Chaumont, Cristobal to Guantanamo, March 2.

Cormorant, at Yorktown.

Henderson, Norfolk to Guantanamo Bay.

Idaho, at Norfolk Yard.

Minneapolis, Delaware Bay to Philadelphia Yard, March 2.

Salinas, at Guantanamo.

Trenton, at Galveston, March 2.

Worden, at Puget Sound Yard (reported movement Feb. 28 should have read "arrived at Port Townsend").

Notice.
